A toaster for your stovetop

STOVES for people on the road can do most of the tasks we take for granted when using our home kitchen cooker with one notable exception: rarely can a camping stove produce a decent piece of toast. And it is on those chilly mornings in the bush that a slab of toast seems most attractive.

Over the years the staff at *On The Road* have used all types of toast-makers but most of them are no match for the Argau stove-top toaster and bruschetta maker.

This toaster has a baked enamel panel that sits on top of virtually any heat source that can be a gas jet, a methylated spirits or petrol burner or even an outdoors campfire.

The panel heats up and reflects the heat upwards where the bread sits on a stainless steel grill.

The toaster is easy to clean and store after use. Just lift up the hinged grill, wipe the enamel panel and put it away. The toaster folds down to a compact 20 by 20 centimetres wide and just one centimetre thick.
